You will be required to wear a face mask while on tour in areas where social distancing cannot be maintained, such as the motor coach and hotel common areas.

## GUEST AND TEAM MEMBER HEALTH

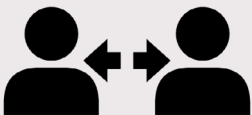


We ask that you follow CDC guidelines prior to your trip, including staying home if you feel ill. Please monitor your health throughout your tour, and notify your Tour Director immediately if you feel unwell.

Prior to joining a tour, we require that each guest show proof of vaccination, a negative COVID-19 test results performed 72 hours prior to travel or documentation of recovery from COVID-19 within 90 days. Our Tour Directors and motor coach suppliers will also meet these requirements.

We will provide you with more details prior to departure. Additionally, we will keep you up to date with any additional pre-departure partner requirements and have provided links to partner websites so you can monitor the latest updates.

## RESPONSIBLE SOCIAL DISTANCING



You will be required to wear a face mask while on tour in areas where proper social distancing cannot be maintained. This includes areas such as motor coaches, hotel common areas, and at certain other venues and sites. You may be rotated in smaller sub-groups when necessary.

## INCREASED CLEANLINESS & SANITATION



Our third-party suppliers including airlines, hotels, motor coaches, and cruise lines have stated that they are implementing enhanced cleaning procedures. Additionally, your Tour Director will have an emergency supply of face masks, hand sanitizer and cleaning supplies to supplement should the need arise.

## ENHANCED TOUR DIRECTOR TRAINING



We have increased our levels of training for Tour Directors. They will be thoroughly trained on all our new health and safety policies. Tour Directors will monitor the hygiene practices of our guests, reacting and advising as needed for the continued safety of everyone.
